(ISC)² is a thriving hybrid operating model with people and chapters across the world. When the organization transitioned to a nearly 100% remote workforce the 30,000 SF headquarters office in Clearwater, Florida no longer fit their needs.

(ISC)² hired Transwestern to help them downsize and relocate to the Washington, D.C. region to be near government contractors, cybersecurity firms and the Pentagon.

Understanding the office needed to reflect (ISC)²'s culture and serve as a home base for collaboration and training, Transwestern identified 625 N Washington St. in Alexandria, Virginia as the prime choice. The 188,000 SF building offers easy access to area airports, public transit and major roadways, and is surrounded by abundant amenities.
