The existing space was outdated and coupled with a location that was not ideal for the company's workforce. The decision was quickly made to look elsewhere, ultimately leading Vectrus to 7901 Jones Branch Drive, otherwise known as the Shenandoah Building, a nine-story, 201,413-square-foot property in the Tysons Corner submarket.

The location, aggressive financial terms, and considerable building amenities achieved Vectrus' desire to affect company culture and brand image with a modern building and space design that not only reduced facilities costs, but also enhanced its ability to recruit and retain a high-quality workforce.

Vectrus committed to a full-floor, 24,411-square-foot space for a 10+ year term.
