Transwestern Development Company was selected by the largest medical complex in the world to develop TMC₃—a five million square -foot campus that brings office, lab, retail, and hospitality together on 37 acres of land in Houston's medical district. When completed, TMC3 is expected to generate \$5.4B in annual economic impact for Texas.

Transwestern is developing both TMC3 Collaborative and Helix Park from the ground up, working with the city and community of Houston to oversee construction, technical management, and programming. Following its construction, Transwestern will be responsible for leasing and managing the property.

The project intends to foster connection through a "DNA necklace" design that will form Helix Park—a greenspace promenade with a walkable and drivable urban street grid. The central hub—TMC3 Collaborative—will serve as the main communal building at the center of the TMC3 Campus. TMC3 will further Texas Medical Center's mission to rapidly drive new research breakthroughs through increased collaboration.
