PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Texas Children's Hospital (TCH), the largest pediatric hospital in the United States, is considered one of the top national pediatric hospitals by U.S. News and World Report. TCH is based in the world-renowned Texas Medical Center. The initial challenge was to help TCH bring a full range of world-class pediatric services to the suburban communities. This model for the future will allow TCH greater access to patients, to treat them before they became critically ill and ensure they receive convenient access to the full continuum of care.

The team deconstructed the traditional, adversarial barriers between designers and contractors and established a single team built on trust, cooperation, accountability, empowerment, and team oriented problem solving.
